• Building on a deep-rooted Olympics legacy.

- Hosted events in the 1932 and 1984 Olympic Games.
- Home to Olympic champions (Wilson High School alumni have competed in every Summer Olympics since 1952).

Creating a legacy beyond 2028.

- The Games will shine a global spotlight on Long Beach.
- Must plan for a safe, organized experience that will introduce the global audience to the arts, culture, and businesses of Long Beach while also maximizing long-term benefits for the community.

Inspiration from Paris 2024

- City of Paris hosted 20 fan zones citywide to extend the Games experience for all beyond the venues.
- Zones featured:
 - Watch parties and live music
 - Local food and cultural showcases
 - Sports clinics and community workshops

Long Beach Hosts Los Angeles **Consular Corps (LACC)**

- LACC fosters diplomatic relationships between countries with consulates in LA
- On April 28, we welcomed the ٠ LACC at the Aquarium to share our Games preparations and invite them to consider Long Beach as their home base during the Games.
- Representatives from 53 countries attended, with over 120 RSVPs
